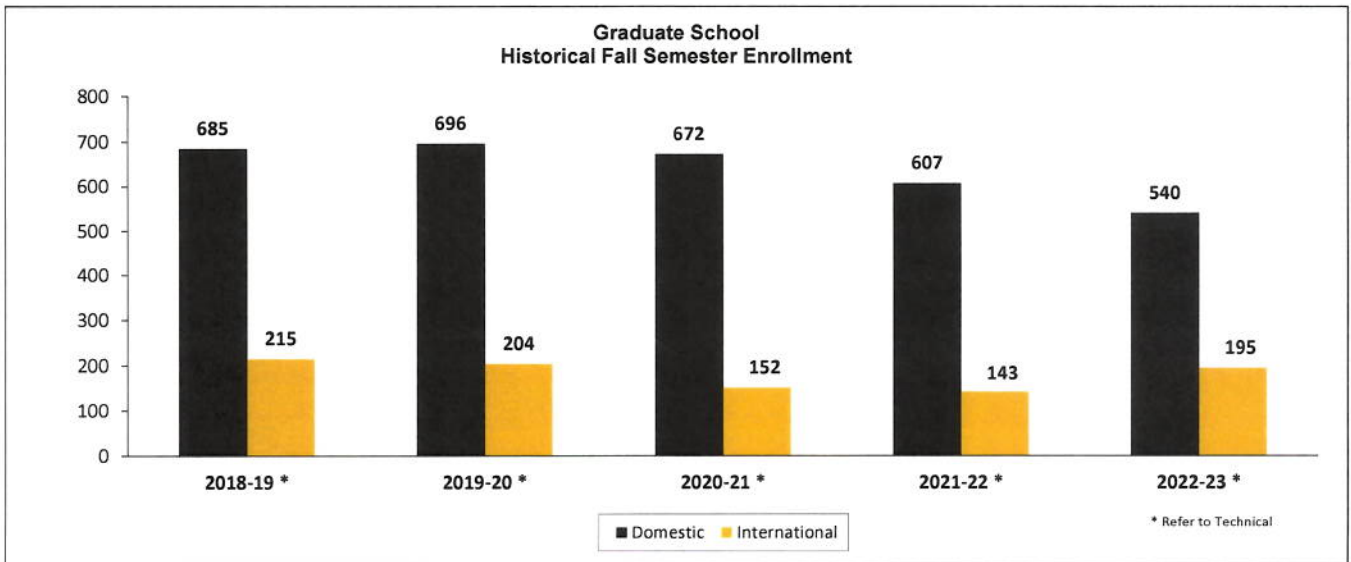


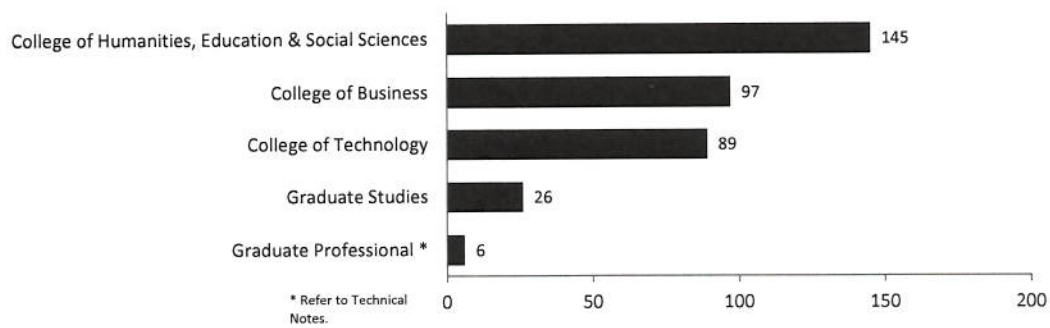

Definitions and Technical Notes

College Of Humanities, Education & Social Sciences education is now housed under this college as of Fall 2016.

Domestic includes all students except for student with an international citizenship.

Graduate Professional is a Doctorate of Nursing Practice.

International Student is identified by citizenship code.

New student is identified as one who applied to and enrolled in a graduate program for the first with an admission term that is the same as the reporting term.

Purdue University Northwest (PNW) is the merger and unification of Purdue University Calumet and Purdue University North Central campuses. The Higher Learning Commission approved the unification on March 4, 2016 and students admitted beginning the Fall 2016 are students of PNW. As part of the unification a new college structure was established and any data prior to the Fall of 2016 is a combination of the two campuses.

Residency is determined by the residence code field in the student information system.
