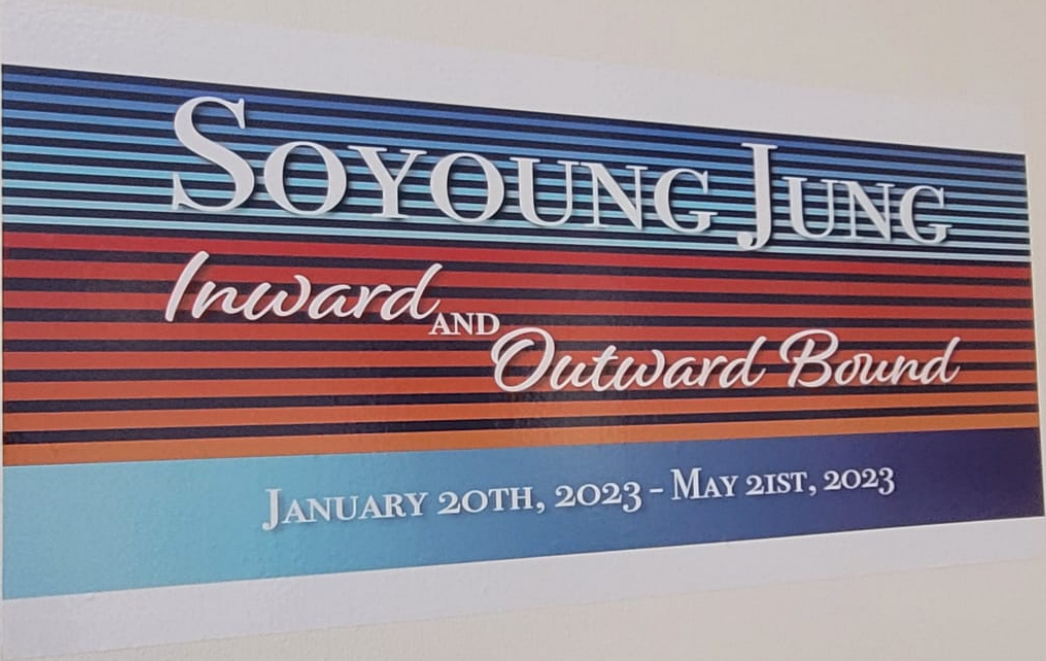
A Week at the AAARCC

As part of professional development activities, the AAARCC staff visited "**Inward and Outward Bound**," a solo exhibition by **Professor Soyoung Jung** (Art and Design, Purdue University). This exhibition is taking place at Shook Gallery, the Art Museum of Greater Lafayette from January 20, 2023 through May 21, 2023.

Gallery description:

Jung typically uses paper in her artwork, particularly handmade Korean mulberry paper, with calligraphy ink and Korean watercolors. By practicing a traditional Korean painting method in her work as she paints her surroundings, Jung seeks to demonstrate a cross-cultural perspective.
