Thank you, Briggita August (Director of Diversity and Inclusion Initiatives, from the College of Liberal Arts) for opening the AAARCC's Fall 2023 Lunch and Learn program. Presenting on "Black and Gold: Black History at Purdue, A Brief Overview," we are looking forward to the Black and Gold Black History tour that Briggitta will be offering in the spring. We had 43 participants at the Lunch & Learn program.

Started around 2017, Lunch and Learn Series has been bringing partnership with more than 65 campus units and more than 1,771 participants (data since Fall 2018). There have been 92 unique presenters and total of 106 of these weekly sessions since Fall 2018. Total average number of attendees rises from 23 in academic year 2019-2020 to 32 in academic year 2022-2023. We look forward to discussing more research, teaching, and engagement related to Asian and Asian American communities!
