

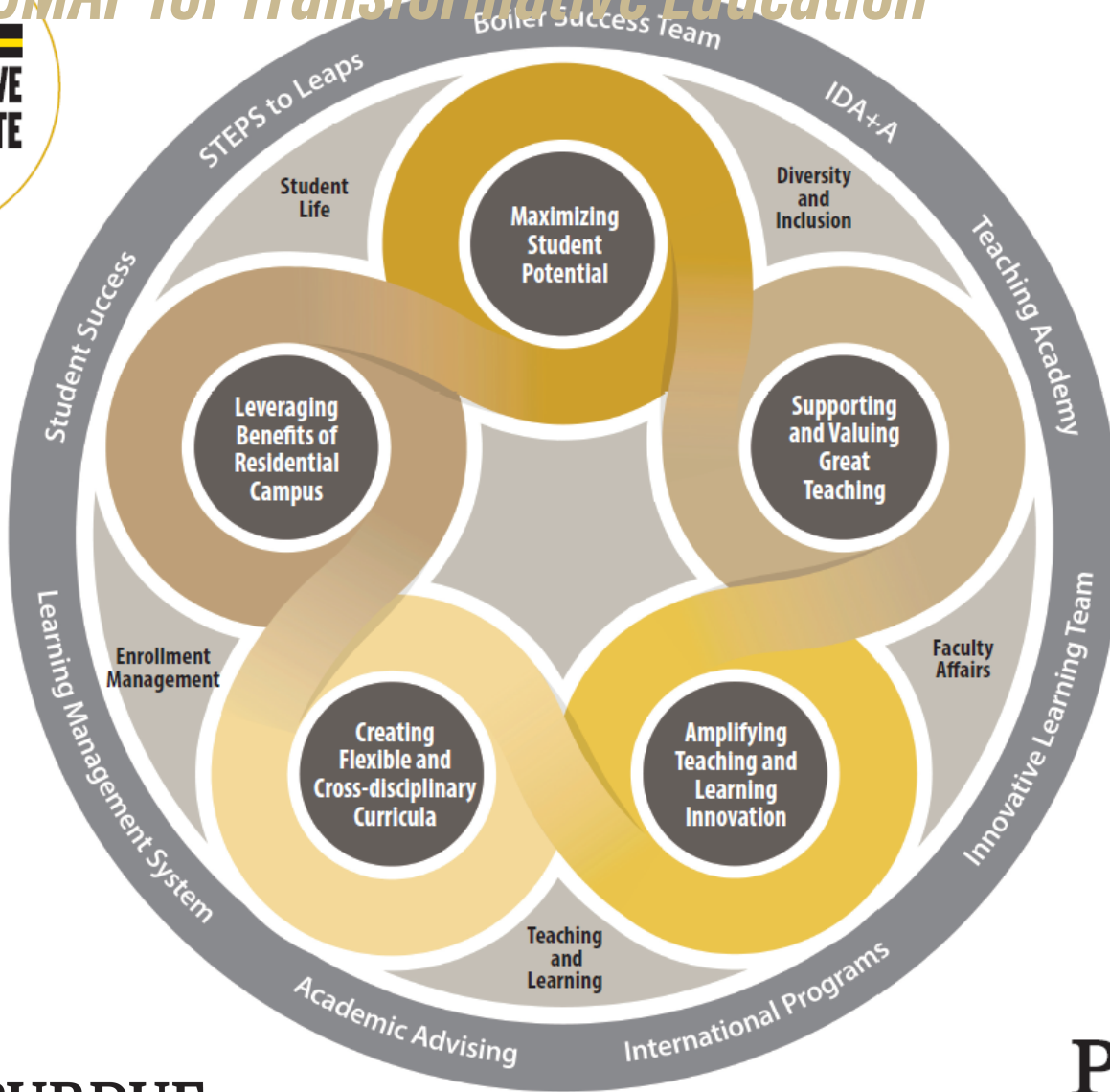

## Transformative Education 2.0



Transformative Education 2.0 will seek to make Purdue the most innovative residential learning program in the U.S. among large research universities through:

- Deep investment in high touch **experiential learning**, such as enhanced internships and cooperative experiences, undergraduate research, and active learning.
- Creative use of **advanced technologies** and online learning to enhance residential courses and improve student success (i.e., time to degree and graduation rate).
- Flexible **cross-disciplinary** degree and credential options.
- Integrated student life experiences and multiple **work/learn** options for paths to graduation.
- A **data-driven** ecosystem that improves retention, progression, graduation and satisfaction.

## Transformative Education 2.0



We will do that by investing in **three projects**:

1. Road Map Foundations: Propelling Student Success
2. Strategic Expansion of Experiential Education
3. Enhancing Student Learning and Classroom Engagement at Scale

## **Engagement with Online Undergraduate Students and Instructors**

Evidence-informed efforts to facilitate interaction and support

### **Spring 2021 Online Undergraduate Students (just over 3000)**

- Weekly messages—offices they were interested in, wellbeing messages connected to Steps to Leaps
- College-based online ambassadors
- Targeted events

### **Spring 2021 Instructors of Online Undergraduate students (just over 600)**

- Weekly messages—teaching persona, strategies for enhancing peer to peer and student-instructor interactions

# Student Success Highlights

## **Mentoring Moments (Center for Career Opportunities)**

- Opportunity/toolkits for instructors to share their career stories
- Piloted last summer--encouraging results particularly for first-generation students

## **Probation Projects (Academic Success Center—Student Success)**

- Evidence-informed messages
- Plan for video project

## **VSTAR-BGR (University Undergraduate Academic Advising & Student Success)**

- Key focus on inclusion, consistency, and belongingness
- BGR opportunity for current online first year students

## **Retention and Diversity (Exploratory Studies)**

- Highest level of retention from first to second year
- Solid increases in underserved populations
