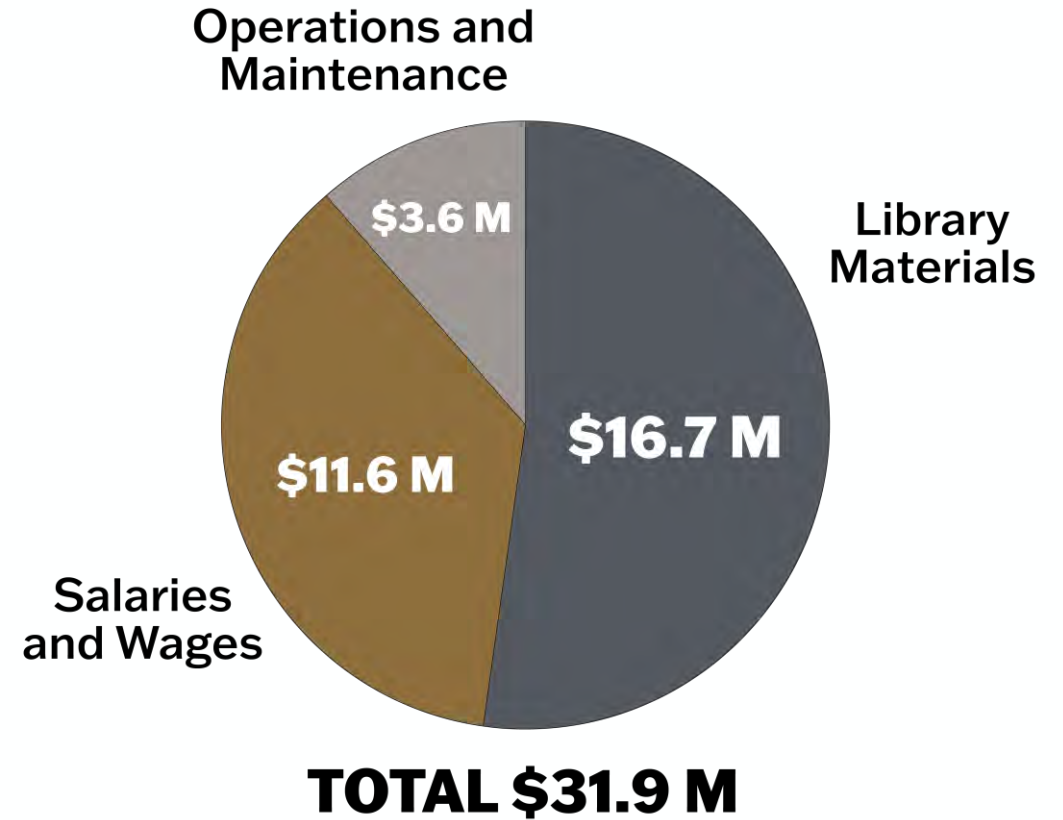
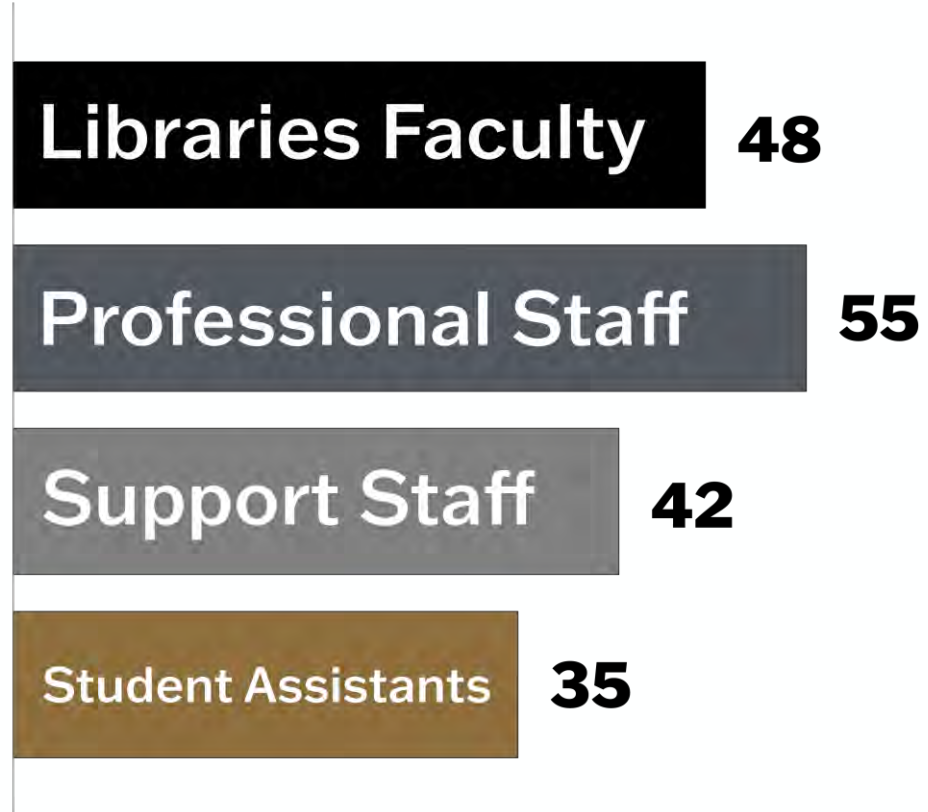

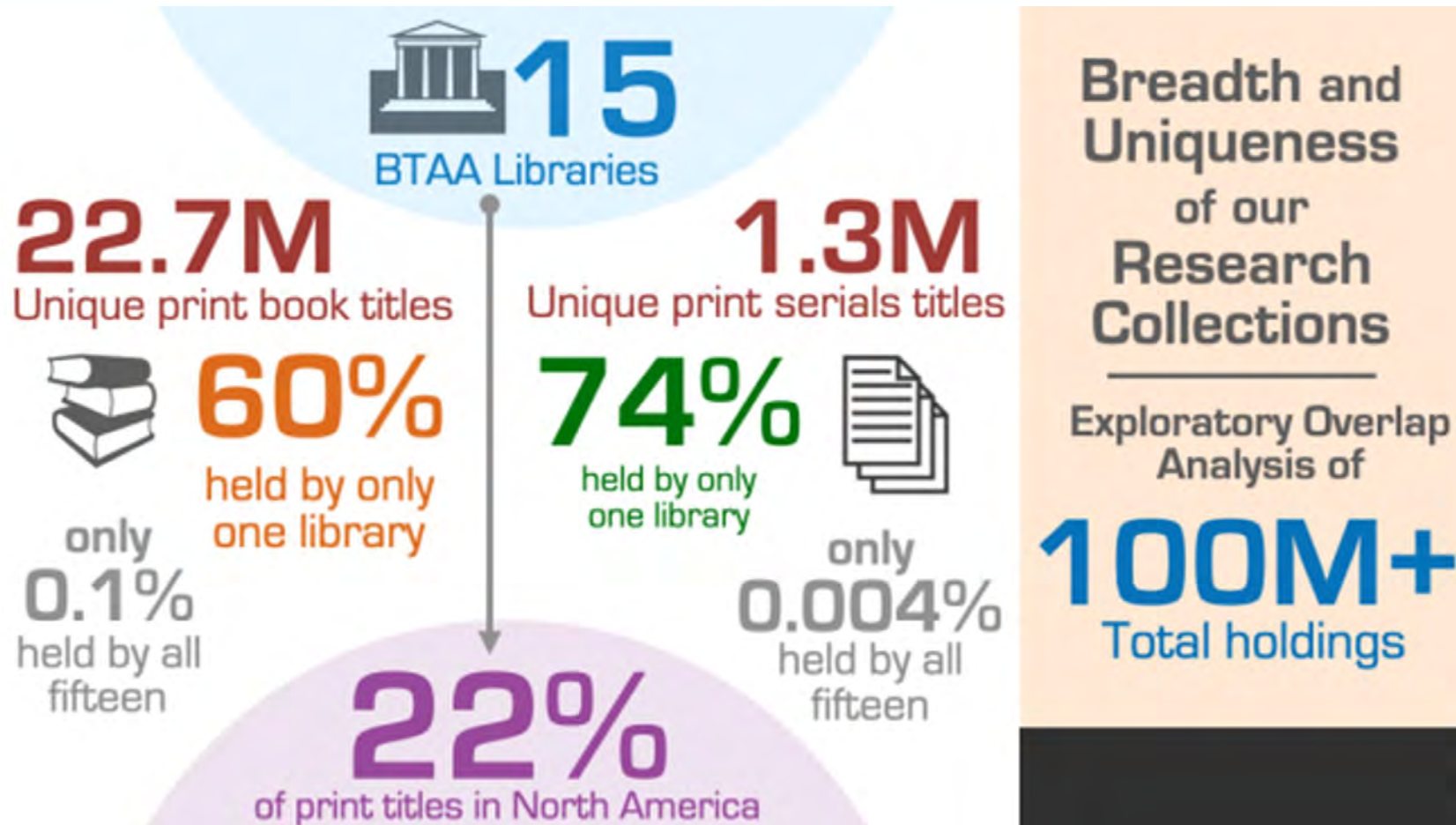

Records Purdue's official history through documents from administration, departments, and student organizations.



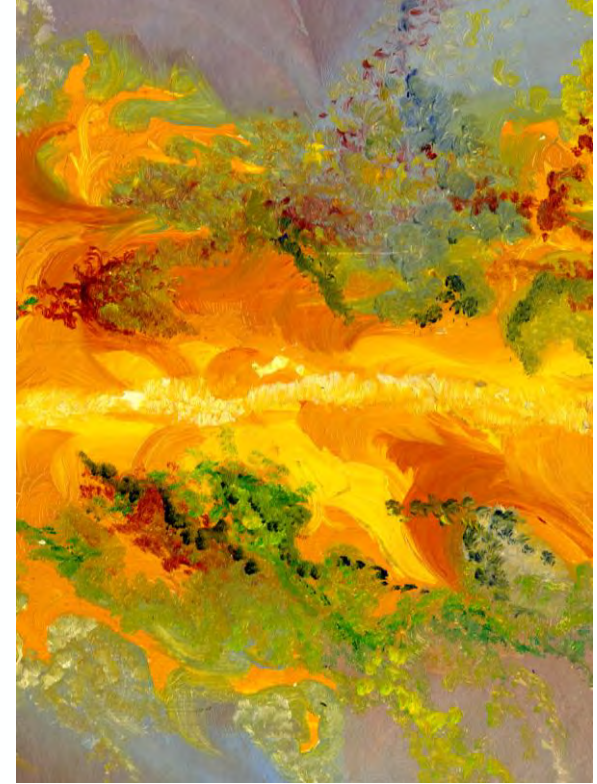
## **The Barron Hilton Flight and Space Exploration Archives**

## **Susan Bulkeley Butler Women's Archives**

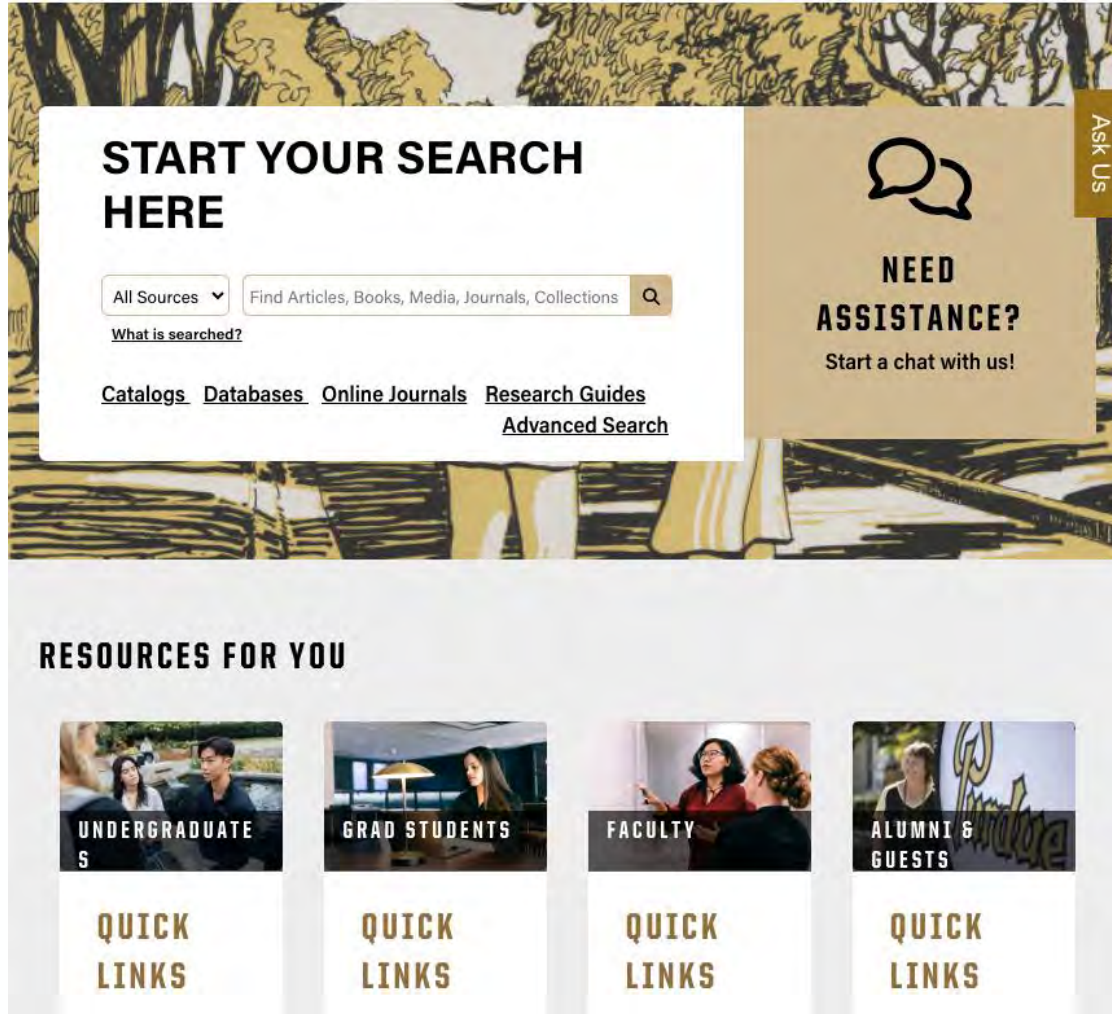
Showcases rare materials highlighting the overlooked stories of women at Purdue and in Indiana.

## Article Express

Delivers requested journal articles via email, often within minutes.



## Purdue Borrow (Fulfillment Network)

Allows users to request book and physical items across Purdue campuses.



## BTAA Resource Sharing

Enables fast, long-term loans through Big Ten Academic Alliance libraries.
