



Thesis/Dissertation Transcript Title Abbreviation Form

Doctoral and masters candidates now have their dissertation titles included on their transcripts. However, current Purdue Banner space limitations only allow for a maximum of 200 characters (including spaces and punctuation) in the title section. Candidates with lengthy titles must therefore abbreviate them sufficiently to meet this space requirement while still permitting full comprehension.

Accordingly, if your title is more than 200 characters, please neatly **print** it, in block letters, in abbreviated form on the four lines shown below. Please print only 50 characters on each line. As a courtesy to your major professor, consult with him or her when formulating your abbreviated title. *Please note that the Graduate School will abbreviate your title in any necessary manner if you do not otherwise provide specific information on how it should be stated.*

Abbreviated Dissertation Title (Spaces and punctuation also count as characters. Due to no wrap-text support, any word not completely fitting on a line will be filled with space and taken down to the next line.)
