# 1. Approval of previous minutes

a) March meeting minutes are accepted.

#### 2. Council members

**a)** AS is introduced as a new council member and introduced to the other members.

VT points out that more council members are required if the PPDA is to survive b) especially since a large number of council members will be finishing their positions at Purdue over the next few months. VT suggests asking people to join council at seminars and the social events. AS enforces this by stating this is how he was recruited! AN says that he would love more members and since some current council members cannot attend the meetings he suggests introducing a system where Postdocs can be members of the subcommittees without being a council member. CH asks whether we had this idea before. KV replies that council wrote it into the constitution to make the system more flexible so as many people as possible could play a role. PR will be asked to put information on the website so Postdocs know they can join at any time and be involved and who to contact. CH asks about displaying information in the ISS office since many Postdocs are international and will have to go to the office at some point. ISS was asked but refrained from displaying information as they didn't want to set precedence for other societies. However, since the PPDA now has official recognition from the university and also functions as a professional development organization then it may be worth asking again. No specific action is decided upon at this time though.

### 4. Update from PR

- a) AN relays a message from DB that she is redrafting the letters originally sent to the Department Heads as a follow up to remind them about the PPDA and the promise they made to distribute flyers about the PPDA to new Postdocs.
- **b)** AN also informs council that an article for the Exponent has been written by the PR subcommittee explaining the role of Postdocs. AN has run the article past Faculty members who have had no comments and therefore the subcommittee will try and get it submitted within the week.
- **c)** Members of the PPDA council will be forming a Postdoc Panel on April 6<sup>th</sup> for a PGSG event allowing Grad students to find out everything they want to know about Postdocs. There will also be a section informing them about the PPDA and similar organizations.
- d) On Monday April 25<sup>th</sup> there will be an Open House. It will be held from 4-5pm in West Lafayette Public Library and is a chance for Postdocs to meet council members, find out about the PPDA and register for tickets for the PPDA dinner. The NPA poster will also be on show and there will be copies of the 'How do I?' information packages. LM suggests making up cards/flyers with upcoming events.

#### 5. Subcommittees

#### 3.1 Seminar Series

**a)** AG informs council that the next Postdoc seminar will be held at 12pm on Tuesday April 19<sup>th</sup> and will be given by Dr David Nelson from CIE on 'Pedagogy in

Academia'. Sherri is currently organizing the room. The event will be advertised on the PPDA website, on Facebook and on Purdue Today. AG asks whether food can be provided again. PD says that he hesitates to provide food again as the PPDA needs to gauge whether people are attending for the right reasons i.e. the value of the information they are gaining from the seminar.

**b)** Another Postdoc seminar is also being arranged with Dr. Mark Smith, Dean of Graduate School, for Monday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> and will be advertized once the room is confirmed.

# 3.2 Survey

- **a)** AN updates council that the IRB request is about to be submitted and then this will allow the next survey to take place, which will probably be during mid-late April. The gift awarded to those completing the survey has still to be decided upon.
- **b)** The former survey has now been written up into a draft. This draft will be finalized by the subcommittee before being presented to council for comments. The paper will then be submitted to a journal.
