
- What does it mean to grant "All Users" access to view your dashboards?
 - Anyone with a Purdue career account or anyone provided the direct link to the dashboard can access it.
 - You are providing access to all internal (Purdue University) and external (Public).
 - See Example A
- What does giving "Guest" access mean?
 - o As a single user account, it represents all unauthenticated users accessing Tableau views.
 - o When enabled, it is a member of the "All Users" group.
- You can continue to use "All Users," but exclude (deny) "Guest" access.
 - If you want to use "All Users" but want to exclude the public from your dashboards, you can manually deny "Guest".
 - Click on Add Group/User Rule and add "Guest"
 - Once added, click on the down arrow to the right and select **Denied**.
 - See Example B
- If you do not want the public to access your dashboards, make sure you have set your permissions appropriately. https://help.tableau.com/current/server/en-us/permissions.htm
