The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:


1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements
2. Most of the requirements for the major


At the time of his death, Benjamin had completed 98% of his degree and was a candidate for May, 2018 graduation. I have attached copies of the supporting documentation.
