Subject: Posthumous Degree

On March 8, 2018, Eric L. Barker, Dean, College of Pharmacy sent a memo requesting a posthumous Doctor of Pharmacy degree from Purdue University, West Lafayette to Benjamin A. Slaven.

The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:

- 1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements
- 2. Most of the requirements for the major
