

First Time In College (FTIC)



FTIC Taking 15+ Hours Fall 2013 to Fall 2017






Undergraduates are becoming more traditional at Purdue Northwest

Currently 79% of PNW Students are Full-Time




Undergraduates Taking 15 or More Hours Fall 2013 to Fall 2017





Average age of Undergraduates has decreased from 24.6 to 23.4 from Fall 2013 to Fall 2017









Impact of Out-Of-State 150% Tuition Percent Change Day to Day (3/26/18)






