Dr. Charles M. Krousgrill currently holds the 150th Anniversary Professorship in the School of Mechanical Engineering. This appointment was initiated in a bridge status; with funding originally coming from the Office of the Provost with the intent that the School of Mechanical Engineering would identify the resources to support this professorship. Recently, Stan Tebbe and the Purdue Research Foundation executed an agreement for an irrevocable planned gift establishing the Tebbe Family 150th Anniversary Professorship in Mechanical Engineering. Furthermore, the donor will provide annual funding for the Tebbe Family 150th Anniversary Professorship beginning in 2022.

Due to the terms outlined in the gift agreement, we request to change Dr. Krousgrill's designation from the 150th Anniversary Professor in Mechanical Engineering to the Tebbe Family 150th Anniversary Professor in Mechanical Engineering.




