
- About 1,100 students are pursuing a Purdue degree at nine Statewide Locations
- 93% are Indiana residents
- Statewide students are "place bound"
- Few of these would attend Purdue if not for this service to the State

Polytechnic Statewide overview

- 68% of students are 25 years old or younger (vs. 45% in 2008)
- 59% are full time (vs. 39% in 2008)
- Most are employed in the region after graduation, bolstering Indiana's "Brain Gain"
- A subset of Polytechnic degrees offered at each Location, with identical requirements
- Degree offerings are matched to regional industry need and local demand

- Significant facilities upgrades in Anderson,
 Columbus, New Albany, and South Bend
