RE: FY 2020 and FY2021 Tuition and Fee Schedule

At the June meeting, we will be seeking approval of the FY 2020 and 2021 Student Tuition and Fee Schedule.

As a reminder, State statute requires that Purdue set its student tuition and fees for a two-year time period. The Indiana Commission for Higher Education, also pursuant to state statute, sets a non-binding recommended fee increase for Indiana resident undergraduate students. Their recommendation for FY 2020 and FY2021 was 0-1.65%.

The detailed schedule of proposed student fees is attached for your reference.

The proposed FY 2020 and FY 2021 Student Tuition and Fees include a 0% increase on general tuition and fees for the West Lafayette Campus and increases on the Flight Program Fees; a 3% average increase in FY20 and a 5.6% average increase in FY21. For the Regional Campuses, the proposal calls for a 1.65% increase on general tuition and fees for PNW and PFW. In addition, PFW will introduce international tuition at \$24.90 per credit hour or \$373.50 per semester for undergraduates and \$31.57 for graduates and a differential fee for College of Visual and Performing Arts at \$25 per credit hour for undergraduates and \$31.57 for graduates.

Consistent with state statute, the changes listed above were presented in a public hearing on May 29, 2019. This hearing was announced on May 16, 2019, and met all requirements of the Indiana Code. No written comments were received prior to the public hearing. During the hearing, there were two questions from the PFW campus. The two questions were: what are the increases in fees at the Regional Campuses being used for and what was the justification for the Visual and Performing Arts Differential Fee. David Wesse replied that the general tuition increase and international tuition will help the University keep pace with the rising cost of living and the cost of providing programs and services necessary to aid in the success of international students. He further indicated that the VPA fee is common for music schools and would support music programs and other VPA programs, such as art and design and theatre which have a higher cost per student than other areas of study.

In addition to the State required tuition and fee approval process, University policy states that the Board of Trustees also approve the following deposits; Krannert Executive Master's Deposit of \$1,500, Krannert Master's Deposit of \$1,000, Engineering Professional Master's Program Deposit of \$500 and a Study Abroad Deposit of \$500. These deposits are not new or increased fees but rather a prepayment of the stated tuition and fees. The deposits have been added to programs that are high in demand to ensure the commitment to the program.

2 Rates apply to audited courses as well as courses for credit.

3 Purdue Northwest Fall/Spring semester part-time Undergraduate students enrolled in less than 12 credit hours in Business, Engineering, Technology, or Nursing programs will be assessed per semester the part-time per credit rate or equivalent and a reduced differential general service fee based on the enrolled program. (For 2019-2020: Business = \$154.51/semester, Engineering=\$221.60/semester, Nursing=\$154.51/semester, Technology=\$205.33/semester). (For 2020-2021: Business = \$157.06/semester, Engineering=\$225.26/semester, Nursing=\$157.06/semester, Technology=\$208.72/semester). Summer semester will be assessed the part-time rate.

4 Purdue Northwest Fall/Spring semester part-time Graduate students enrolled in less than 8 credit hours in Business, Engineering, Technology, or Nursing programs will be assessed per semester the part-time per credit rate or equivalent and a reduced differential general service fee based on the enrolled program. (For 2019-2020: Business = \$205.33/semester, Engineering=\$247.01/semester, Nursing=\$205.33/semester, Technology=\$247.01/semester). (For 2020-2021: Business = \$208.72/semester, Engineering=\$251.09/semester, Nursing=\$208.72/semester, Technology=\$251.09/semester). Summer semester will be assessed the part-time rate.

5 Except Honors College, students with dual degrees will be charged the higher of the two differential fees. Honors College will be assessed in addition to other differential.

6 Students continuously enrolled prior to Summer 2018 will not be charged the Honors College Differential until attainment of one degree, or until the Fall of 2021 semester, whichever comes first. All Honors College students will be assessed the differential effective Fall 2021.

7 Technology fee is charged to all students except Graduate Staff and Graduate School Fellows. This fee is non-refundable except as mandated by Title IV regulations.

8 Remittances will not be applied towards the Repair and Rehabilitation fee, and this fee is non-refundable except as mandated by Title IV regulations.

9 Student Fitness and Wellness fee and Student Activity fee are not charged to Part-time (including Veterinary Medicine per credit hour assessed students) and Statewide Technology students. These fees are refundable. Remittances will not be applied towards the Student Fitness and Wellness fee or the Student Activity fee. Students not charged Student Fitness and Wellness fee and Student Activity fee will pay a user fee if the student uses the Rec Sports facility.

10 Regular Fall/Spring semester part-time students enrolled in 1-7 credit hours, except Veterinary Medicine, will be assessed per semester the part-time per credit rate or equivalent and a percentage of the approved differential general service fee based on the following hours: 1-3 hours=25%, 4-7 hours=50%, 8 hours and above=100%. Veterinary Medicine Fall/Spring semester students enrolled in 1-11 credit hours* will be assessed the part-time per credit rate and the per credit rate differential general service fee based on the Veterinary Medicine page of this Student Fee Schedule. *(1-11 credit hour rates are applicable for Veterinary Medicine students when there are extenuating circumstances only – Department Approval Required. All other Veterinary Medicine students are full-time at 8 credit hours and above.)

11 Summer students, except PharmD and Veterinary Medicine (non-trimester program), will be assessed the Undergraduate/Graduate regular summer approved rates as included in this Student Fee Schedule and a percentage of the approved differential general service fee based on the following hours: 1-5 hours=25%, 6-9 hours=50%, 10 hours and above=100%. PharmD summer and Veterinary Medicine summer (non-trimester) students will be assessed the

Undergraduate/Graduate regular summer approved rates as included in this Student Fee Schedule but will not be assessed the differential general service fee.

12 This is a market based fee increment for a Professional Masters Program developed through a rate approval process when the program is established.

13 Doctor of Nursing Practice Tuition and Fees are non-remittable.

14 Students continuously enrolled prior to Summer 2015 will not be charged the Computer Science Differential until attainment of one degree, or until the Fall of 2020 semester, whichever comes first. All Computer Science students will be assessed the differential effective Fall 2020.

15 These rates apply to all Polytechnic Statewide locations, unless they are affiliated with another academic institution.

16 Lab fees are based on a standard number of hours required to complete training. Any additional hours will be billed based upon approved proficiency rates.

17 Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP) of the Midwestern Higher Education Compact (MHEC) at Regional Campuses: Purdue Fort Wayne's MSEP tuition is 150% of regular in-state tuition for new Undergraduate students enrolled Fall 2017 and thereafter. Northwest does not participate in MSEP but will allow MSEP students continuously enrolled to remain in MSEP status.

18 Children of Staff, Spouse of Staff, and Spouse of Official Retirees will also be required to pay all applicable special fees including deposits, workshop, laboratory, and differential fees. Children of Staff, Spouse of Staff, and Spouse of Official Retirees who do not reside in the State of Indiana will also be charged nonresident tuition on all campuses if staff member is not paying income taxes to the State of Indiana. These same three groups of students, West Lafayette undergraduate only, will also be charged the International Student Tuition (if applicable). Spouse of Staff (per Policy II.D.3) enrolled as nonresident students may have the nonresident tuition remitted. Children of Staff rates apply only to undergraduate students.

19 Undergraduate Children of Staff (W. Lafayette only) will be required to pay the full-time rate when credit hours are over seven per semester for the Fall/Spring semesters and over five for summer. Spouse of Staff and Spouse of Official Retirees will be required to pay the regular fee rate for each undergraduate or graduate hour over the maximum (per Policy II.D.3). Children of Staff rates apply only to undergraduate students.

20 Staff will be required to pay all applicable special fees including deposits, workshop, laboratory and differential fees. All staff will pay the full resident/nonresident tuition amount on the credit hours over the maximum. Audited courses are assessed for all applicable special fees including deposits, workshop, laboratory, and differential fees only (per Policy II.D.3).

21 The Summer rate is one-half of the Fall/Spring semester rate.

22 At West Lafayette, students will also pay all applicable special fees including deposits, workshop, laboratory, and differential fees per semester.

23 Graduate School Fellows consist of the following: Fredrick N. Andrews, George Washington Carver, Lynn, Purdue Doctoral, Ross, Charles C. Chappelle, Bilsand Dissertation, Nick Puskas, David M. Knox, Ludwig Kruhe, and Bilsand Strategic Initiative.

24 These rates are applicable for students that qualify for the Graduate Tuition Scholarship Fee.

25 Spouse of Graduate Staff will also pay all applicable special fees including deposits, workshop, laboratory, and differential fees per semester. Per Policy II.D.3, Spouse of Graduate Staff enrolled as nonresident students may have the nonresident tuition remitted. West Lafayette undergraduate only will also be charged the International Student Tuition (if applicable).

26 University Residences Staff Residents and Resident Assistants Undergraduate and Graduate Summer fee rates will be one-half of the Fall/Spring semesters. West Lafayette undergraduate only will also be charged the International Student Tuition (if applicable).

27 International Student fee is not applicable for students who are enrolled in Purdue Online programs. This fee is applicable to all other international students as well as those international students in the Professional Master's Programs.

28 The Late Graduation Deadline fee (West Lafayette graduate students only) is applicable for late arrival of the Electronic Plan of Study to the Graduate School, late declaration of degree candidacy, late deposit of a thesis or dissertation, updating/correcting a thesis or dissertation after it has been deposited, or listing on the Graduate School's candidate roster for the same degree three or more consecutive sessions.

29 Dual Credit Program refers to high school students taking a course taught by high school faculty at the high school. Dual Credit Priority Only Course rates will be set by the Indiana Commission for Higher Education. (Note: Concurrent Enrollment Program refers to high school students taking a course taught by our faculty (regardless of site or location). The fees for concurrent enrollment programs will be assessed at the regular part-time credit hour rates as included in this Student Fee Schedule.)

30 For West Lafayette, Lab Course fees will be implemented selectively based on criteria approved by the Provost and Treasurer. For a Regional Campus, Lab Course fees will be implemented selectively based on criteria approved by the Regional Campus Chancellor or their designee.

31 The Non Instructional Rate will be charged to students registered at non Purdue sites using Purdue facilities. This per semester rate includes Technology fee, Repair and Rehabilitation fee, Student Fitness and Wellness fee, and Student Activity fee. In addition, a charge for Student Health Center fee will be assessed.

32 Payment of the application fee for a graduate certificate or degree-seeking program at PFW, PNW, or PWL enables the applicant to apply, within a one-year period, to one graduate program at each of the other two campuses at no cost. Non-degree applicants to the Graduate School do not pay an application fee.

33 Undergraduate admission deposits will be applied towards tuition or related fees. For new students who apply for housing, \$100 of the deposit will apply towards application fees for residence with university housing. All admission deposits are non-refundable.

34 This rate applies to Purdue Northwest Domestic Nonresident students enrolled prior to Fall 2018 and all International students.
