This letter is a request to change Prof. Melba Crawford's Named Professorship from the Chair of Excellence in Earth Observation to the Nancy Uridil and Francis Bossu Professor in Civil Engineering. Because of research interests and career plan, Prof. Melba Crawford's appointment was recently changed to 75% Civil Engineering and 25% Agronomy. The School of Civil Engineering has targeted a Named Professorship for Prof. Melba Crawford that would better reflect her current appointment and research interests. This would also release the Chair of Excellence in Earth Observation named professorship back to the College of Agriculture.
