

SUBJECT: College of Veterinary Medicine Representation on the Indiana Board of Animal Health (IBOAH)

I was recently informed by the Indiana Board of Animal Health (IBOAH) that Dr. Sandy San Miguel's appointment to the board will expire soon. She is eligible for reappointment and I recommend that Sandy San Miguel, Professor and Associate Dean for Engagement, be reappointed as the College of Veterinary Medicine's representative on the board.

Dr. San Miguel is imminently qualified to serve on the IBOAH because of her training and experience as a swine veterinarian and because of her previous experience in working with the board through her activities as the former co-director of Purdue University's Homeland Security Institute.

Indiana State Law pertaining to the IBOAH related to the College of Veterinary Medicine's representative to the board is as follows:

IC 15-17-3-2

Membership

Sec. 2. The board consists of eleven (11) members appointed by the governor as follows:
(1) One (1) member from the School of Veterinary Medicine of Purdue University upon the recommendation of the Purdue University Board of Trustees




