Purdue Polytechnic High School

- 2 Indianapolis locations open; Pursuing 3rd in South Bend
- **430 students** enrolled in 2019-20
- 37% black, 21% Latino, 7% 1 or more race,
- ≈115 graduates will become the inaugural class of 2021
- Scholarship fund launched
















Learning Communities: Freshmen only



% of Spring enrollment studying in Summer




Purdue leads Big Ten in Summer Growth
