Commitment to Purdue and the State of Indiana: Profound commitment, involvement, leadership and service toward Purdue University or to the State of Indiana; exceptional participation, demonstration, and commitment to the betterment of the student body, faculty, and on-campus involvement; and generosity toward the evolution of making Purdue University and the community a better place.
