The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:


1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements

At the time of her death, Abigail had completed 94% of her degree and was a candidate for graduation August 2020. I have attached copies of the supporting documentation.


