Subject: Posthumous Degree

On November 11, 2020, David J. Russomanno, PhD, Dean, School of Engineering and Technology sent a memo requesting a posthumous Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering from Indiana University-Purdue University to Rutuj S. Gavankar.

The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:

- 1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements
- 2. Most of the requirements for the major
