Tuition and Fees Simplification

- Current fee structure includes six types of fees
 - Standard, college, degree, course, study abroad and Purdue Online fees
 - Students assessed at least 5 and possibly 10 or more fees dependent upon residency and registration
 - Substantially fewer fees than other universities but opportunities exist to simplify
- First phase of simplification to be implemented in Fall 2021 with standard fee consolidation
 - Standard fees are assessed to all students based on residency
 - Technology and R&R fees combined with In-State Tuition
 - International Tuition and International Fee combined
- Second phase to reduce non-standard fees to be implemented in Fall 2022
 - Existing fees to be reviewed with academic leadership in FY22 to determine whether each should be continued or eliminated
 - Stringent governance of non-standard fees and a biennial approval process
