**RE:** Request approval to name the Mary J. Hanna-Elmore Pavilion and Mary J. Hanna Elmore East Terrace and Mary J. Hanna Elmore West Terrace.

On behalf of Purdue for Life Foundation, I respectfully ask that the naming committee consider naming the east and west terraces located on the ground floor of the Purdue Memorial Union as the Mary J. Hanna-Elmore East Terrace and Mary J. Hanna-Elmore West Terrace, respectively. Collectively the terraces will be referred to as the "Mary J. Hanna-Elmore Pavilion".

The Elmore Fund, a donor advised fund of the Marin Community Foundation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, with the recommendation and encouragement of Mary J. Elmore (MJ), has agreed to provide Purdue University with a \$1,500,000 cash gift in support of the University's renovation of the Purdue Memorial Union. MJ is a 1976 graduate of the College of Science with a Mathematics major. Because of previous giving, she has received the lifetime honor of the Pinnacle Award from Purdue's President's Council. Additionally, she has been awarded the College of Science's highest alumni distinction as a Distinguished Alum. As a student she was involved in the Alpha Xi Delta sorority and Grand Prix.

Naming the Mary J. Hanna-Elmore East Terrace and Mary J. Hanna-Elmore West Terrace in recognition of the Elmore Fund and the Marin Community Foundation's continued support and generosity towards the Purdue Memorial Union's renovation project is requested. As members of the Purdue Naming Committee, please consider moving this opportunity forward for president and Board approval to name the Mary J. Hanna-Elmore Pavilion, and the Mary J. Hanna-Elmore East and Mary J. Hanna-Elmore West terraces.
