Good news

- Rapidly rising: UG program enrollments, student quality (especially in new majors), and student success.
- Graduate programs doubled in size, refocused on highly ranked, profitable programs, new modalities
- Extremely productive and nationally recognized faculty
- Strong financial position from growth in varied revenue streams
- Excellent staff capabilities in Mar/Comm, Data Analytics

Challenges

- Retirements => sharp decline in the number of senior faculty leaders.
- Heavy teaching loads => poor availability of experiential learning for students
- Space limits growth, quality of student experience







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
Enrollment & New Degrees

New Majors: IBE, Business Analytics, Supply Chain/Operations Management








Student Success & Student Experience



Excellence at Scale:

- UG enrollment 2400=>4000
- Double (or more) Grad Enrollment
- Reach 20% of Purdue UG with Business Minor

- Modern facility that reflects scale, new pedagogy, experiential learning, corporate partnerships

Transformative Learning

- Major expansion in experiential and project based courses.
- Leadership immersion, case/data competitions, undergraduate research, corporate consulting, study abroad
- New teaching and learning ecosystem
- Produces agile, critical thinkers capable of seeing and then tackling the world's biggest problems.

Cornerstone for Business

- Use transformative texts to immerse students in history, philosophy, economics of business and markets.
- Understand they "why" not just the "how" of business.
- Complement with intensive focus on business writing, case presentation in order to greatly enhance student ability to speak well, write well, interact well.

When Krannert was founded, the top of the Fortune 500 was dominated by oil, steel, plastics, heavy industry. Firms that head today's Fortune 500 (tech, pharma, healthcare, multimodal retailers) hadn't been founded.

We will prepare our students to lead industries we don't yet know exist.



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
