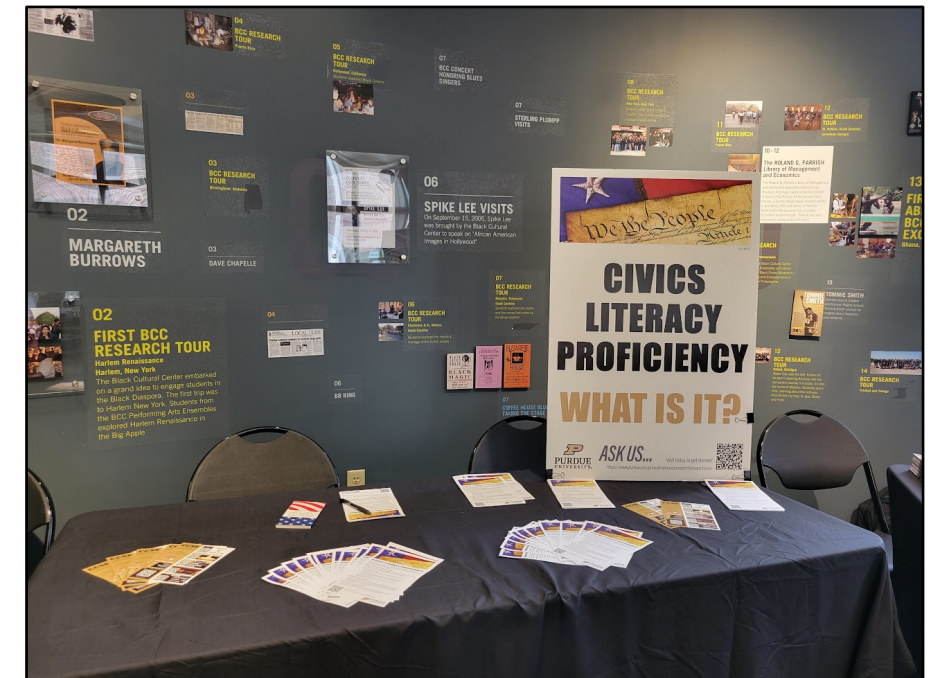

- **Creating student awareness**
 - Outreach: 6 student-facing events most recently, Fall 2022
 - Visibility: New Office 1st Floor Krach, near student activities
- **Scaling up/Scaling out pathways to completion**
 - 700+ exams taken in January 2023
 - Supported Fall 2022 launch at PFW, PNW, and IUPUI

Transformative Education 2.0 strengthens the individual success of Boilermakers as we drive toward excellence at scale in co-creating talents, jobs, and knowledge.




Next-generation upgrades to our academic infrastructure, focused on the student experience:

Implementing an AI-assisted, dynamic & personalized degree planning tool (EduNav) that optimizes individual student choices based on major and career goals.

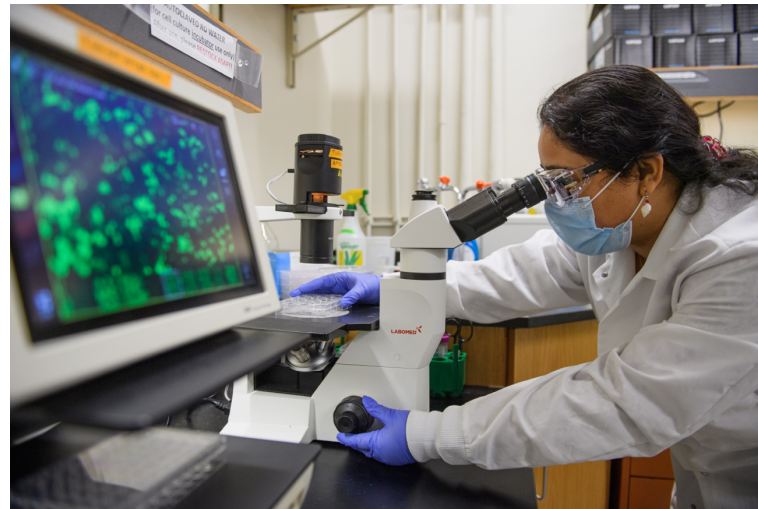
