
Enterprise Risk Management Program Update



ERM Process



- Integrates framework for holistically managing enterprise risks to achieve organizational objectives and minimize unexpected disruption
- Focuses on major risks that could affect Purdue long-term positioning and performance
- Provides common platform for discussion of risk throughout the University

The risk identification and evaluation was an *inclusive and collaborative process* that considered many functional areas.

Additionally, external benchmarking was performed to align with current industry trends and risk landscape.



Embedding ERM into Operations: Phase 4

- Focus on embedding ERM into a risk-aware culture
- Operationalizing ERM and promoting accountability
- Validating the effectiveness of risk mitigation activities/ continuous monitoring



- Regular stakeholder engagement with ERM milestones and expectations
- Complete tests of effectiveness of the risk mitigation activities defined by Risk Owners
- Regular reporting of the test results and KRIs to key stakeholders
- Consider including ERM milestones in annual performance goals of Risk Owner and relevant university staff
- The future goal of the program is to implement an integrated Audit/ERM system
- Use a data-driven approach
- Automate KRI monitoring and reporting via interactive dashboards.
