# Namings

## Request to name the Kevin and Suzanne Kahn Sustainable Green Roof and Patio

- Donors: Kevin (1973 College of Science) and Suzanne (1974 College of Health and Human Sciences) Kahn
- Gift Plan: Support the Data Science renovation construction project

## Request to name the John Martinson Entertainment and Engineering Laboratories

- Donor: John Martinson (1971 School of Aeronautics and Astronautics)
- Gift Plan: Create and support the John Martinson Strategic Development Fund to aid the Fusion Studio in developing new initiatives such as an online professional certificate in structural engineering, high school summer camps and the establishment of four entertainment and design laboratory spaces in STEW



# *Purdue Wins 3 out of 3 National Hub Competitions*

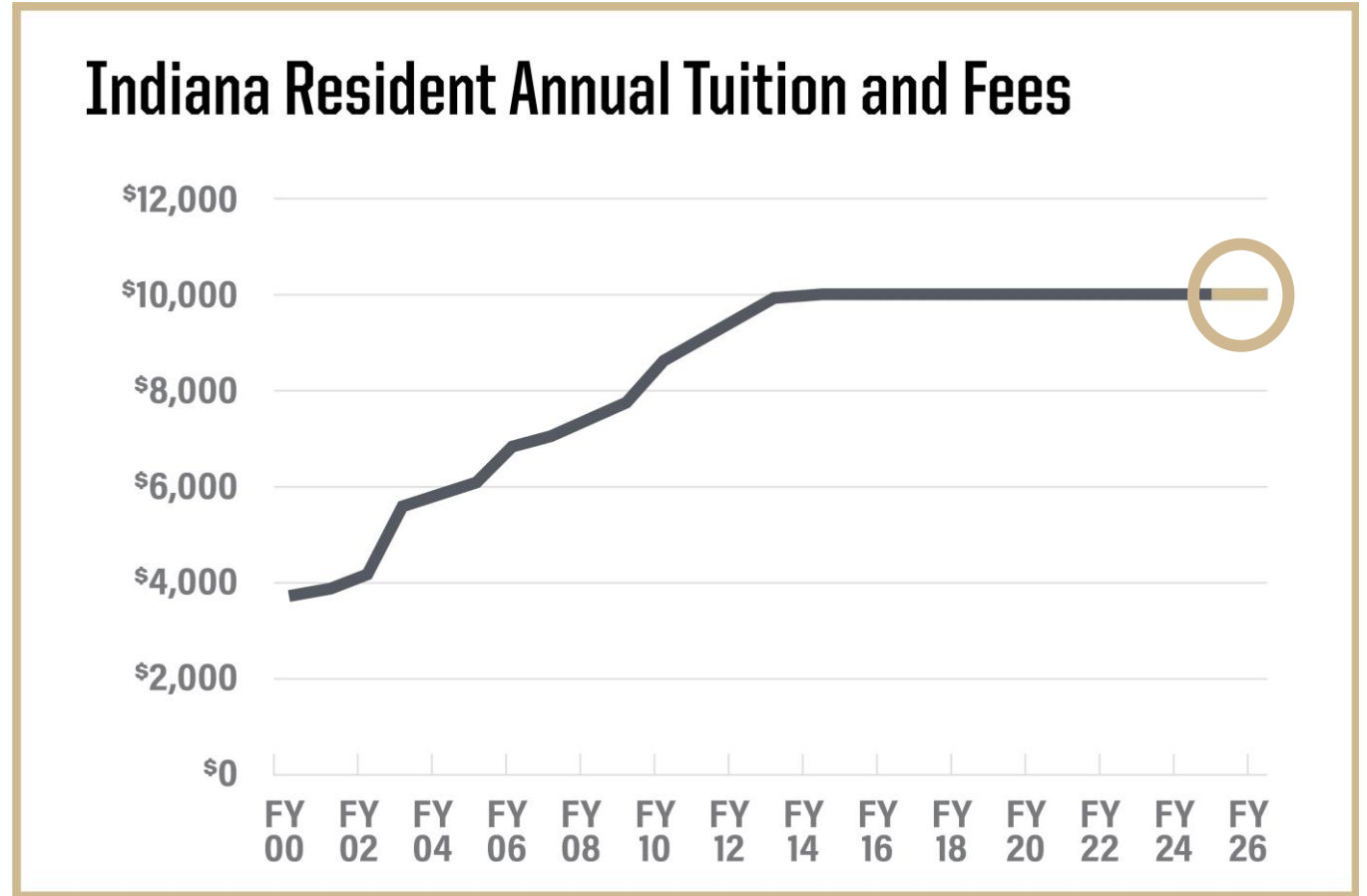
As part of the Applied Research Institute team in Indiana, Purdue secured three federal hub designations in fall 2023, each with a 10% success rate:

- **Midwest Alliance for Clean Hydrogen Hub (DOE)**
  - Purdue University Northwest is the only university in Indiana to secure a hydrogen hub.
- **Silicon Crossroads Microelectronics Commons Hub (DOD)**
  - The Microelectronics Commons Hub is based on Purdue West Lafayette's strength in semiconductors.
- **Regional Technology and Innovation Heartland BioWorks Hub (DOC)**
  - The regional tech hub is in the Indianapolis metropolitan statistical area, where Purdue University in Indianapolis is opening in July.



# West Lafayette Tuition Freeze - 13th Year

- 2025-26 will be the **13th** year of frozen tuition
- Indiana residents continue to pay **less than \$10,000** per year
  - 20% less than if Purdue increased tuition at the Big Ten average rate
- Students and families have **saved over \$1.4B** to date from the tuition freeze



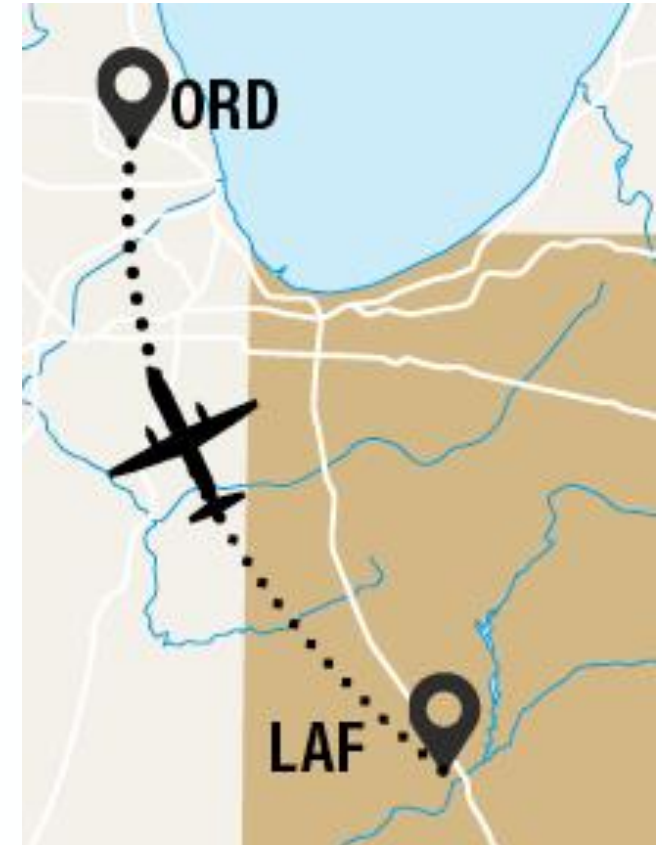

# *Purdue University Airport Airline Service*

- Commercial service returns to LAF for the first time since 2004
- Service scheduled to start in April 2024
- Purdue partnering with Southern Airways to provide daily service to O'Hare International Airport
- Southern has direct partnerships with American Airlines, United Airlines and Alaska Airlines
- Key part of Purdue's ABCD Strategy: **Purdue Flies** to support rapid economic growth for our state and Greater Lafayette
- Result of strong teaming with federal, state and local partners across west central Indiana, including READI support for terminal and FAA support for runway
