On February 21, 2025, Arvind Raman, Dean of the College of Engineering sent a memo requesting a posthumous Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering at Purdue be awarded.

The policy states the awarding of a posthumous degree by Purdue University requires that the deceased student completed:

- 1. At least 85% of the credit hour requirements
- 2. Most of the requirements for the major
