Actions to take when encountering a flood

- Floods can happen anywhere at any time due to water pipe breaks, valve failure or by accidental release.
- If you see evidence of an active water leak call 911 immediately! Floods are considered an emergency situation.
- Do not enter the area! It is possible that the water may be electrified depending on the situation and entering may cause serious injury or even death.
- EHS will assist in drying the area and restoring it to pre-flood conditions.
 Even for small floods, water can aid in the growth of suspected fungal growth behind walls. Leave the clean up to EHS.

 If an area is either currently under water or clean-up is in progress, please stay out of the area so crews can quickly and safely remediate the area to allow business to resume as usual.
