Proper Containers Prevent Spills and Injuries

Routinely Inspect

Look for the following indicators that a container is compromised:

- Leaks: Puddles or crystals around the bottle or lid.
- Cracks: Small cracks may be difficult to see, be sure to inspect closely.
- Discoloration: Bottles and lids can discolor with age and become fragile.

Remove

- Have unneeded chemicals and damaged bottles removed by submitting a pickup request using the Environmental Health and Safety Assistant (EHSA) portal.
