Battery Disposal Quick Reference

Alkaline batteries are the only batteries that can be disposed of in the regular trash. Purdue University does not collect or recycle alkaline batteries.

Batteries that must be submitted to REM for disposal include:


- Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cad)
- Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH)
- Lithium ion (Li-ion)
- Lithium Polymer(Li-Po)
- Sealed Lead-Acid Batteries
- Batteries containing heavy metals (Lead, Cadmium, Mercury, etc.)
- Any rechargeable battery
