- b. There will be three problems on the exam: one involving concept questions and two in-depth problems similar to homework problems.
- c. You will need to bring your calculator, pencils, and eraser. **Any model of the following series of calculators, TI-30X or TI-36X or Casio-FX-115 or Casio-FX-991, is permitted on the exam. Instructors do not provide calculators.**
- d. Equation sheet and any required property tables will be provided with the exam.
