Academics

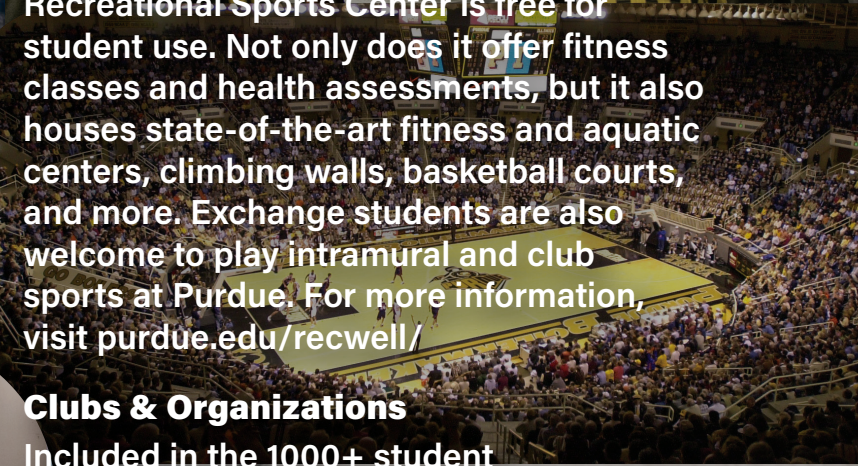
