



If you've been recommended to have a hysterectomy, you aren't alone. Hysterectomies are the second most common surgery for women in the US. There are various reasons why your doctor might recommend this procedure, including:

- **Fibroids**: Non-cancerous growths in the uterus that can cause heavy bleeding, pain, and pressure.
- **Endometriosis**: A condition where uterine tissue grows outside the uterus, leading to pain, irregular bleeding, and potential fertility issues.
- Adenomyosis: When the uterine lining grows into the uterine muscle wall, causing heavy bleeding and painful periods.
- Prolapse: When the uterus descends into the vagina, causing discomfort and pressure.
- Cancer: In cases of uterine, cervical, or ovarian cancer, a hysterectomy may be necessary.
- Abnormal Bleeding: Heavy or prolonged menstrual bleeding that doesn't respond to other treatments.
