



NEW INDIANA LTAP PASER PROGRAM

Indiana LTAP is updating its PASER program to integrate Quality Control and Quality Assurance initiatives to better serve local agency asset management needs. This program will be available in 2025 but will not be required for compliance until 2026.

QUALITY CONTROL

The primary goal of the quality control initiative is to ensure consistency of the PASER program among local agencies and/or LPA consultants.

New Requirements for Quality Control

1 PASER CERTIFICATION

- Individuals performing PASER ratings for Pavement Asset Management Plans (PAMP) will need to be certified through LTAP
- Each Certified PASER Rater (CPR) will have a unique ID to tie the CPR to the road segment evaluated
- Initial PASER certification requires participation in a full-day workshop

2 PASER RECERTIFICATION

- Each CPR will need to complete recertification training every 2 years
- Available online through the LTAP Learning Management System

3 QUALITY CONTROL FIELD REVIEW (exempt for communities with less than 10 centerline miles of roads)

- Review of at least 10 road segments by an independent certified PASER rater
- Intended to be an instructive process to identify and rectify any errors or omissions

4 PAVEMENT ASSET MANAGEMENT PLAN VALIDATION

- Each agency will submit four documents to the LTAP Data Management System for their PAMP:
 - Inventory and Condition Ratings
 - 5-Year Treatment Plan
 - Objectives and Measures
 - Quality Control Field Forms (**NEW**)
- Prior to confirming submission, each agency will certify that the information uploaded is accurate

QUALITY ASSURANCE

The primary goal of the quality control initiative is to ensure consistency of the PASER program among local agencies and/or LPA consultants.

New Requirements for Quality Assurance

1 VALIDATE SUBMITTED PASER DATA

- A random sample of road segments will be selected for review by a team of Certified Quality Assurance PASER Raters (CPR-QA)
- The CPR-QA team will report results to LTAP for statewide analysis

2 CERTIFIED QUALITY ASSURANCE PASER RATER (CPR-QA)

- Obtain credentials as a Certified PASER Rater
- Attend in-person CPR-QA training and pass final exam
- Participate and pass the Control Road Segment Rating field test
