Summer Undergraduate Research Programs

UM-SMART Program

UM-SMART is designed for undergraduate students who have an interest in obtaining a combined MD/PhD degree leading to a career in academic medicine as a physician-scientist performing basic research relevant to human health and disease. As a UM-SMART summer research fellow, students work full-time in a basic research laboratory under the mentorship of a research faculty member. Participants receive a stipend, housing, and meal allowance. Application deadline is January 31, 2022. Program dates are May 31, 2022 - August 5, 2022. Summer Health Professions Education Program

SHPEP is a free six-week summer enrichment program focused on improving access to information and resources for college students interested in the health professions. Participants receive housing, meals, a stipend, and travel assistance. Additionally, they receive guidance from current admissions deans, health professionals, students, and SHPEP alumni about how to pursue their profession of interest. Curricula and program dates vary by program site but the application deadline is February 5, 2022. To learn more and apply, visit the website.

The University of Detroit Mercy School of Dentistry Summer Enrichment Program
