

Credit Hour Computations Using No Substitutes

The Student CRF will now take into consideration courses that are marked as 'No Subs' from the Advisor CRF when computing minimum and maximum requested credits. This means that substitute courses will not replace any course marked as a no sub. Ultimately, this reduces the number of courses the solver can consider because it will exclude those courses marked as no substitute. This may reduce the number of credit hour override requests advisors will see.

- 1) The first four priorities marked as no-sub (same numbers as total priority credit).
