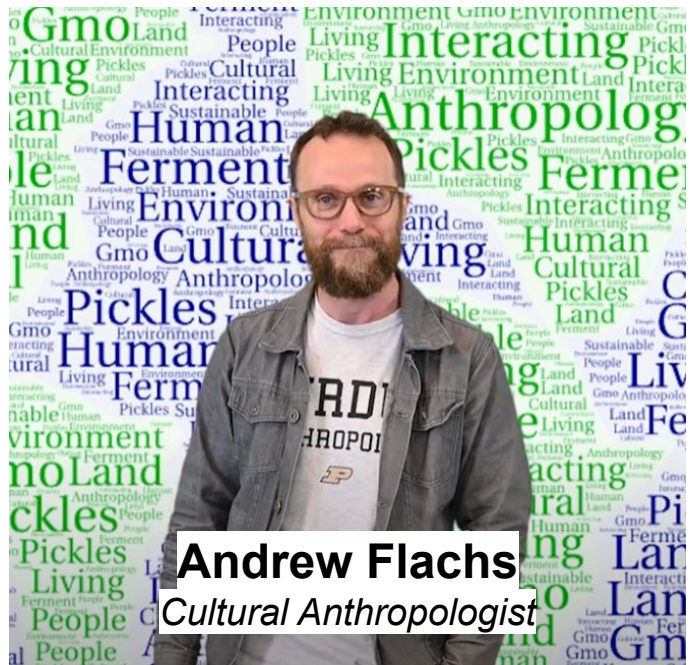

Some of the day-to-day jobs of a cultural anthropologist include:

- ❑ Spending time in **communities** to observe and participate in daily activities to understand **cultural practices**.
- ❑ Analyzing qualitative data to identify patterns, themes, or cultural meanings.
- ❑ Comparing observations with existing anthropological theories.
- ❑ Participating in cultural **preservation** efforts, like documenting endangered languages or **traditions**.
- ❑ Writing grant proposals to secure funding for research projects.
