Winter Session Course Dates | Dec. 16, 2024 - Jan. 3, 2025

- 11 instructional days, with university holidays not counting as instructional time
- Monday, Dec. 16 Friday, Dec. 20 (5)
 - o Monday, Dec. 23 Wednesday, Dec. 25: Winter Recess Starts & University Holidays, No class
- Thursday, Dec. 26 Friday, Dec. 27 (2)
- Monday, Dec. 30 Tuesday, Dec. 31 (2)
 - Wednesday, Jan. 1, 2025: University Holiday, No class and End of Winter Recess
- Thursday, Jan. 2 Friday, Jan. 3 (2)
- Tuesday, Jan. 7, 2025: Grades are due by 5:00 pm (Eastern Time)
 - Grades posted after being processed
- Monday, Jan. 13, 2025: Spring Semester Starts <u>2024-2025 Academic Calendar</u>
 - o 4th Week of Winter Break this year

What Will Class be Like? - Planning for Success

- 3 credits in 3-weeks
 - Normally students earn 3 credits in a span of 15-weeks
 - o This means Winter Courses require a larger time commitment each week. (Up to 30hrs.)
- Access Brightspace Early
 - Pay Attention to the announcements made via <u>Brightspace</u>
 - Professors don't always email the class with important information, so be sure to check Brightspace regularly.
- Read the syllabus!
 - Write important dates on a planner/Calander
 - o Have all necessary materials before the first day of class (textbooks, notebooks, etc.)
- Coursework, Assignments, and Tests
 - Will be compact throughout the three weeks. Be mindful of holidays and due dates
- Reach out to your faculty member as soon as you have questions
- Make sure to have a reliable internet connection.
- Time management is *crucial!*
 - Set aside a designated time to work on your course every day. Plan around other important events work/family

 - Students enrolled in Winter Session will have their Spring semester start dates changed to allow for disbursement of aid in December, starting December 6.
 - o Office of the Bursar tuition payment
- Registration and Withdrawals
 - Sunday, Dec. 15: Last day to receive a 100% refund for withdrawing from a course
 - Monday, Dec. 16: Session Starts; Last day to withdraw without a "W"
 - Tuesday, Dec. 31: Last day to withdraw with a "W" complete the Withdraw form in myPurdue to drop course
 - Students withdrawing from their winter course assignments after classes have begun should go to <u>myPurdue</u>, Registration tab, and look for Withdraw Information
 - Office of Dean of Students will process withdrawals as students would be withdrawing from a term
