


What is Financial Responsibility?

Financial Responsibility is an important step for all students to complete each year. Students can review and update their annual agreement by visiting the **Bills & Payments** page via mypurdue.purdue.edu and click the link "Affirmation of Financial Responsibility" found within the **Student Account** section. Doing so will automatically release the hold on your account. Lack of compliance will result in your inability to register for classes, including the ability to drop or add courses.
